## **Two-Step Verification**

- Initially, there are two main options, the **Microsoft Authenticator App** and **Personal Phone**, that you may set up.
- Initially, you need to set up one option, and you may <u>add or manage your Sign-in</u>

  Methods later.
- When you are locked out of your account to reset your 2 Step Verification methods, submit a request to tcmi.edu/support; a TCM staff will contact you but be ready to confirm your identity.
- See the Official Two-step Verification guide from Microsoft.

**TCM enforces Two-Step Verification** on all accounts to provide SSO (Single Sign On), increase security, and minimize user risks.

## Phone number

- 1. Have your **telephone** and the **device you want to setup** ready
  - This will require a working telephone, registered on a local mobile network (in some cases, SMS charges may apply)
- 2. Navigate to mail.tcmi.edu or any other TCM digital service requiring SSO
- 3. Type your **TCM created** email address and click **Next** 
  - If you typed a correct email address you will see the TCM logo in the next step
- 4. Enter Your Password and click Next
  - If you do not know your password, click Forgot my password and follow the instructions
- 5. More Information Required, click Next
- On the Keep your account secure screen choose I want to set up a different method (small black text)
- 7. Choose **Phone** in the new window and **Confirm**

- 8. Choose your **Country** from the list, add your **phone number**, select **Text me a code**, and click **Next**
- Check your **phone** and enter the code received from Microsoft back on the new **Phone** window
  - If you have not received a code, check your phone number and click resend or go back and correct it
- 10. Once the verification is successful, click **Next**, and you will be taken to your Inbox or the resource you were navigating to.

## **Microsoft Authenticator App**

- 1. Have a mobile device and device you want to setup ready.
  - This will require a mobile device with an operating system up to date and an
    official app store containing the <u>Microsoft Authenticator App</u>
- 2. Navigate to mail.tcmi.edu or any other TCM digital service requiring SSO
- 3. Type your **TCM created** email address and click **Next** 
  - if you typed a correct email address, you will see the TCM logo in the next step
- 4. Enter Your Password, and click Next
  - if you do not know your password click Forgot my password and follow the instructions
- 5. More Information Required, click Next
- 6. While on the **Keep your account secure** screen
  - Go to your mobile device and install the Microsoft Authenticator app
  - Open the Microsoft Authenticator app on your mobile device, click on the + icon and choose Add Work or School Account; Scan a QR code
- 7. Return to the device you were setting up and click next and **Show QR Code**
- 8. **Scan the QR code** with your device's camera
- 9. Approve the test Notification on your mobile device.

10. Once Verification is successful, click **Next**, then **Done**, and you will be taken to your Inbox or the resource you were navigating to.
